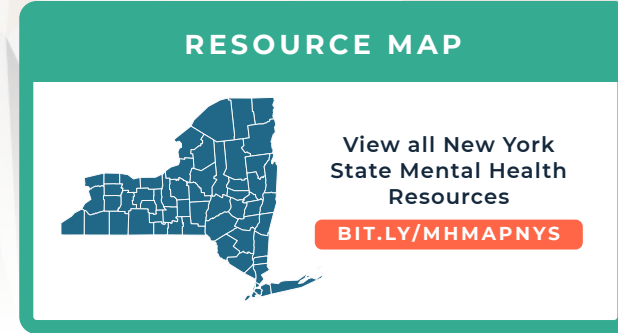

COUNTY PAGES

The data and resource information contained in this NYS KIDS COUNT Multimedia Data Book 2020 are a snapshot of the available social and emotional resources for children, youth and young adults in New York State. This Data Book was compiled during the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) when many New Yorkers were experiencing heightened feelings of isolation, anxiety and stress. We hope that by sharing this Book New York children and families have more readily available information about resources and are better able to find and access help.

We, at the New York State Council on Children and Families, recognize that mental health is so crucial to supporting the resilience of children and families, especially during this unprecedented time and for children and youth who have been disproportionately affected by COVID-19. While no New Yorker is immune from the impact of COVID-19, children and families

experiencing multiple hardships and living in communities of color, immigrant and low-income neighborhoods are particularly affected.

This Data Book includes information and resources, broken down by county and borough, that are not commonly grouped together because of differences in age or program eligibility. The Council's intention was to provide an easy and centralized compilation of mental health services for all children, regardless of age, to better equip children, youth, young adults and families to navigate through this crisis.

Note: For all the resources included in this Data Book, it is recommended that you contact the agency to find out more about specific services that are available and to determine whether the agency is serving families in person or via telehealth.

The data and resource information contained in NYS KIDS COUNT Multimedia Data Book 2020 are a snapshot of the social and emotional development of children and adults in each of our counties.

We included data that was unique and not commonly put together because of the age group or program eligibility. We wanted to highlight early childhood resources as well as resources for older youth.


