

Part 1: Role Set-up & Access to PIDS

If your classroom staff needs to be assigned the Classroom Data Collector Role in PIDS. Please fill

- **1.** out the <u>PIDS User Change Form</u>. The NYS PIDS State Administrator will create the account or add a new role to an existing account. You will then be contacted via email.

- 2. any role that can edit the Pyramid Model Professionals Dashboard) needs to set up and link the person's professional profile to the classroom. Follow the steps below:






Race and ethnicity data is vital to a culturally responsive program.






<u>Part 2: Data Entry using the Classroom Data</u> <u>Collector Role</u>


2. Select the Classroom Data Collector Role.







The Classroom Data Collector will <u>only</u> have access to enter child level data for their assigned classroom(s). The role will also have access to view classroom level data for their own classroom (i.e. TPOT/TPITOS). Below are the PIDS dashboards the Classroom Data Collector has access to:



The dashboards include only classroom and child level data tools.
Professional and Program level data are not available.

note: The Classroom Data Collector role will also be given access to view the the Classroom Coaching Log when an update on the log is complete.


4. Select the dashboard you would like to access. The next page shows an example of the Children and TPOT Dashboard.






4a. Example of the Children Dashboard.

Note: The Classroom Data Collector Role will have access to **view** TPOT/TPITOS observations.








Part 3: Data Analysis using the Classroom Data Collector Role

1. The Classroom Data Collector role has access to PIDS reports to assess their classroom and child-level data. Navigate to the "Reports" page at the top of the screen.




2. Select the report you are looking to run. Each report includes a detailed description and documentation.








Filter your report. The filters will include any classroom(s) and children the Classroom Data Collector was assigned to.
