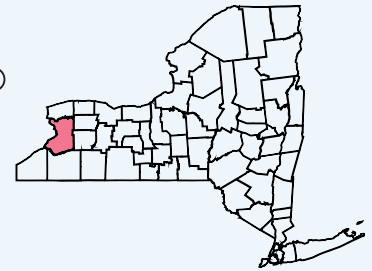

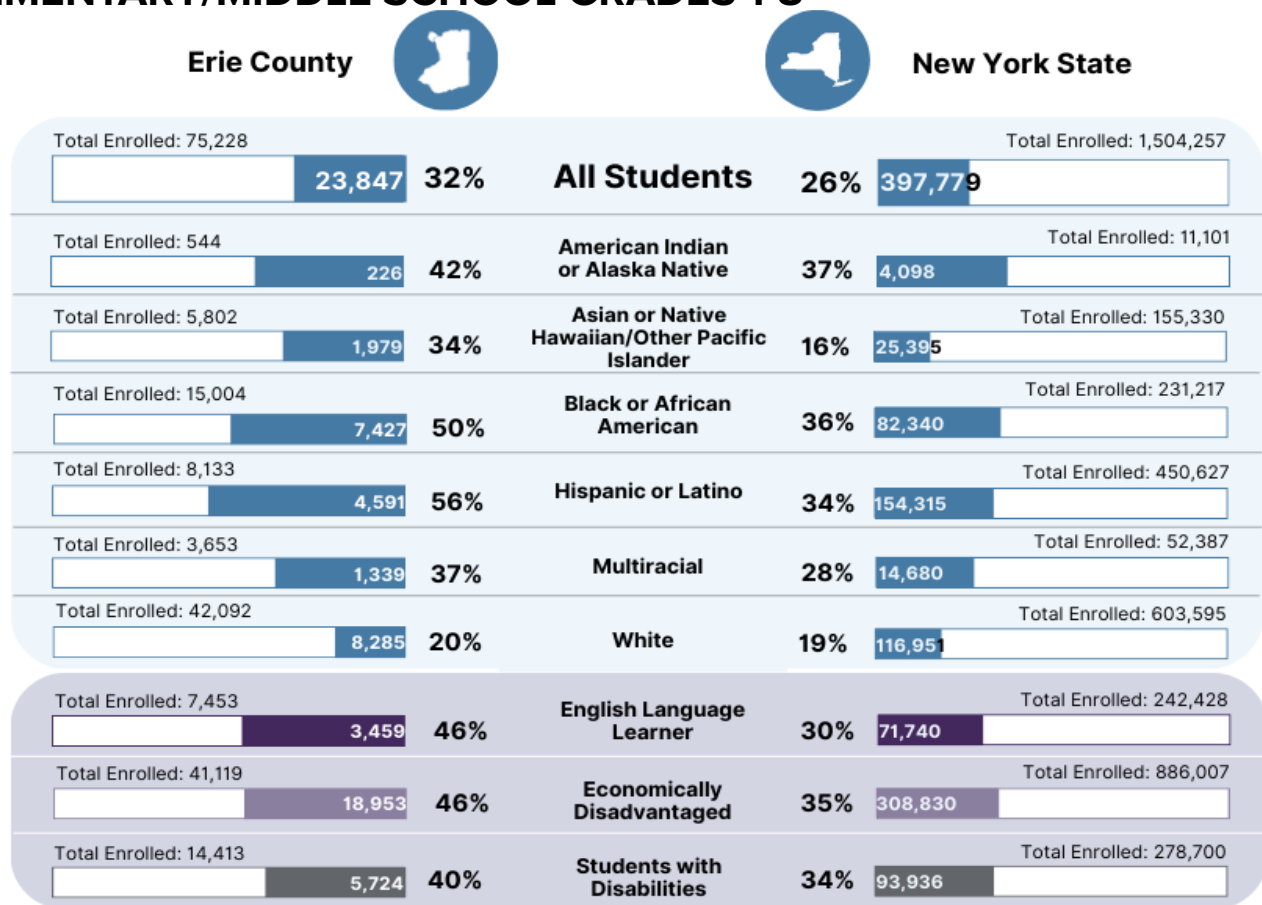

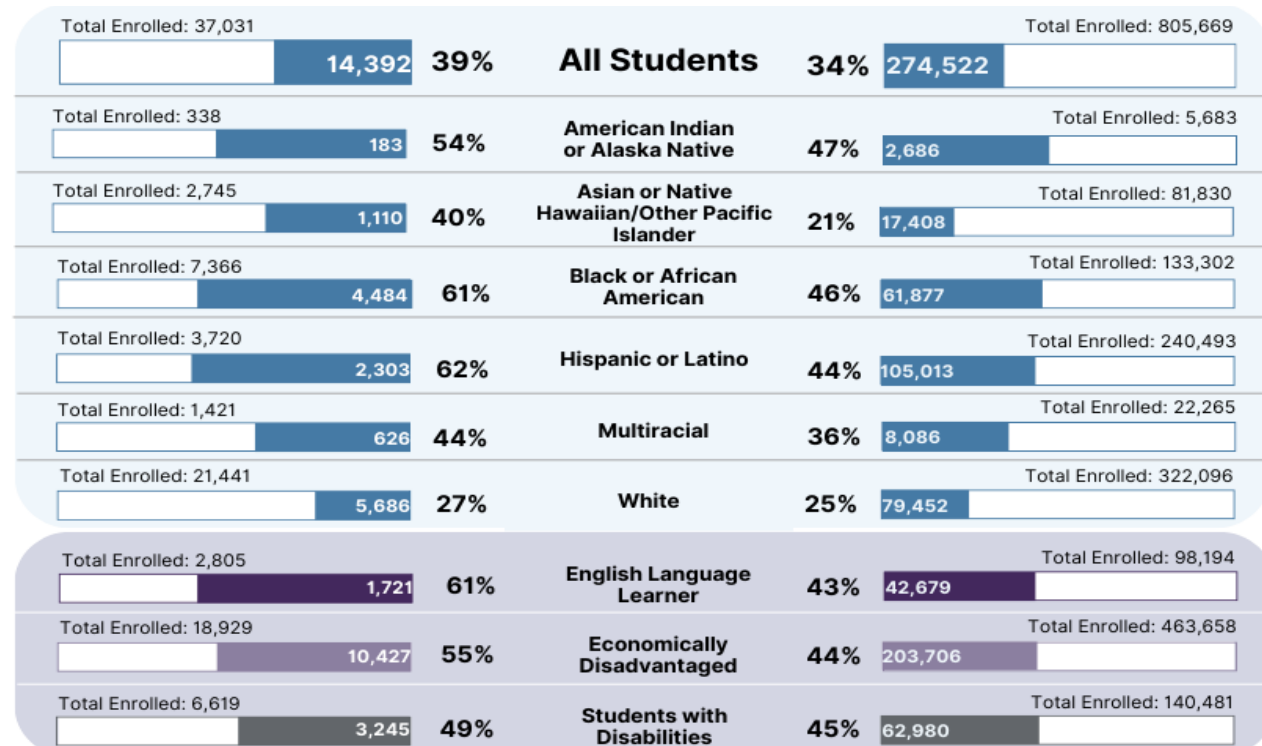

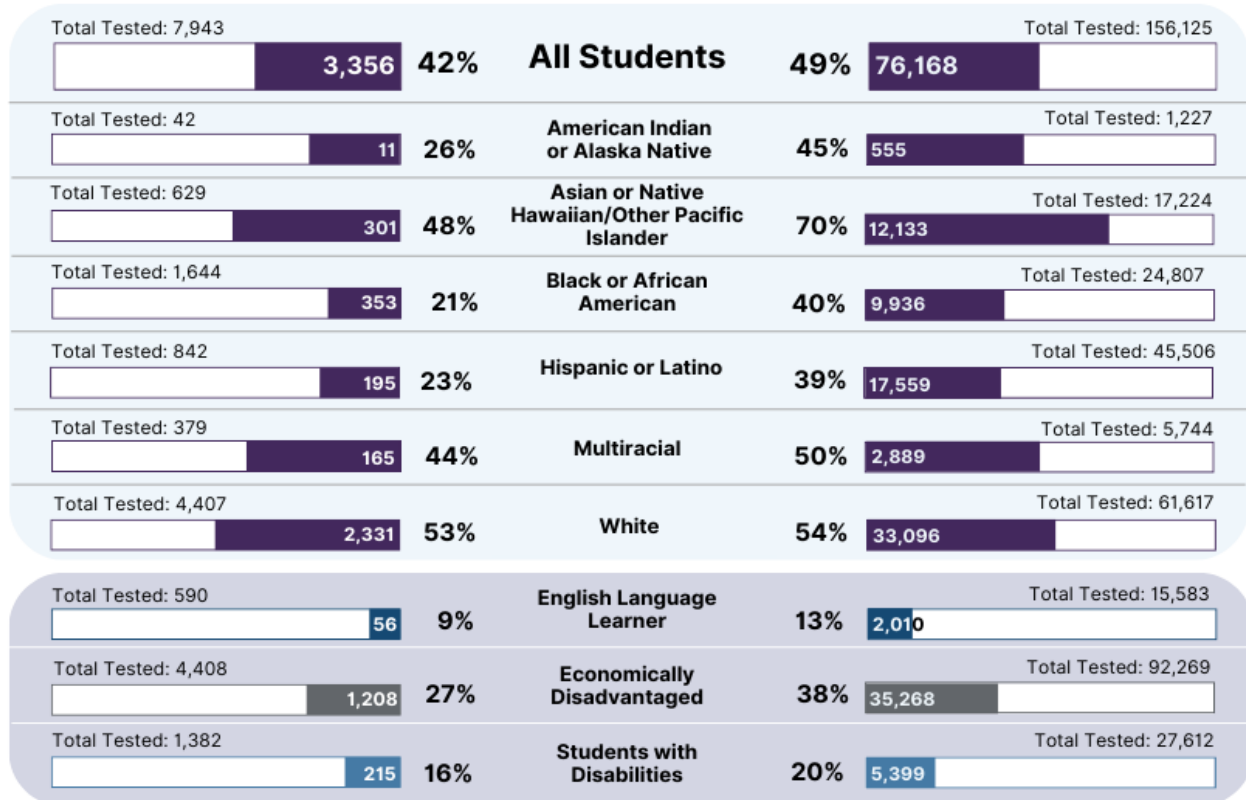
PROFICIENCY RATES (2022-2023)

4TH GRADE READING

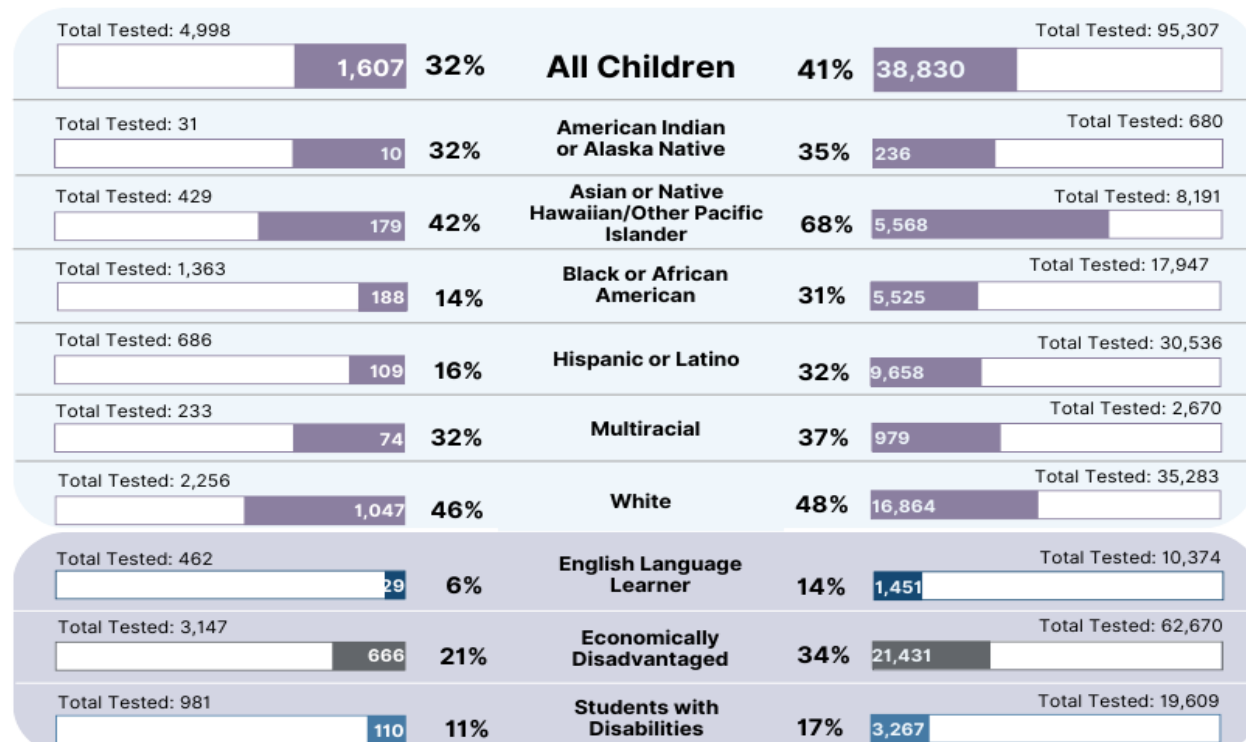
