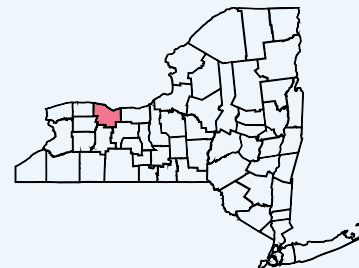

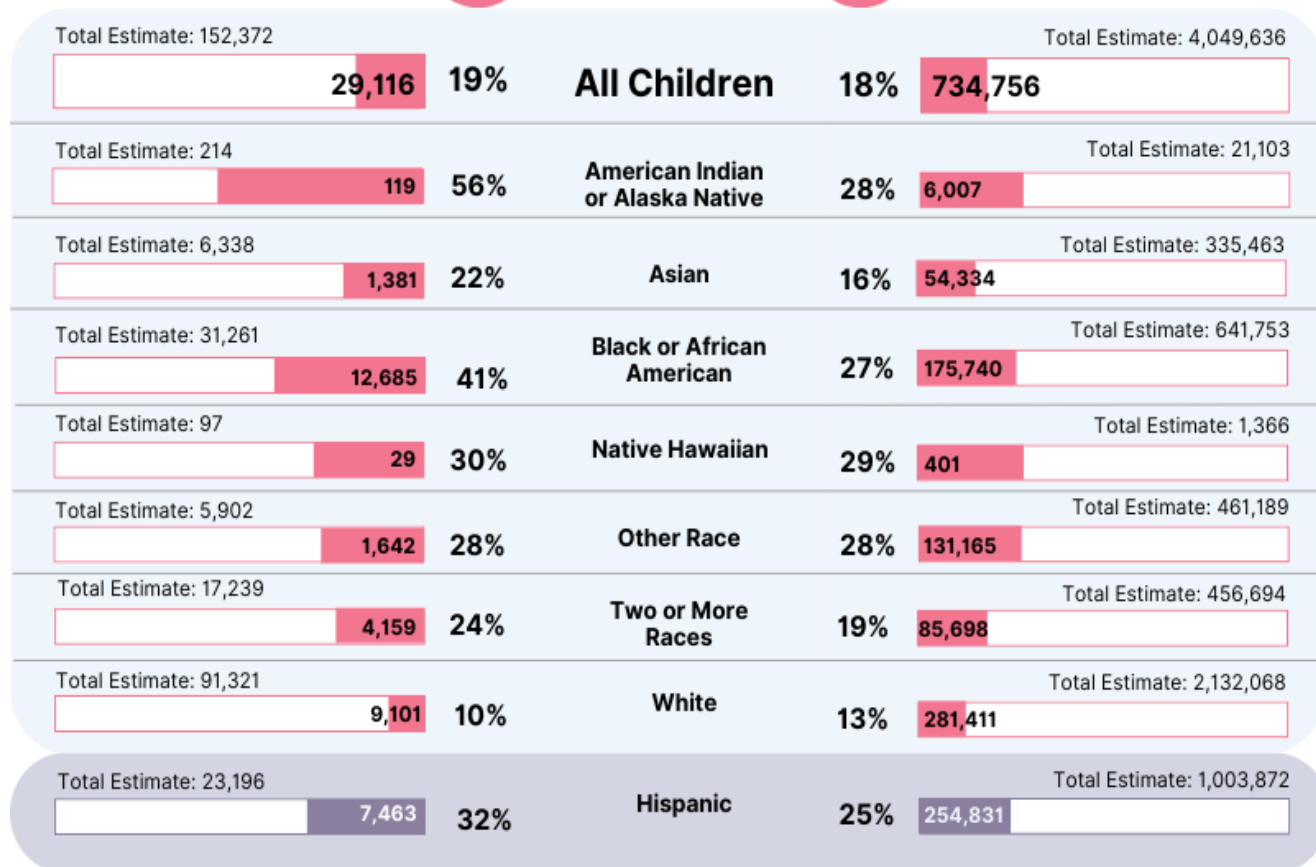

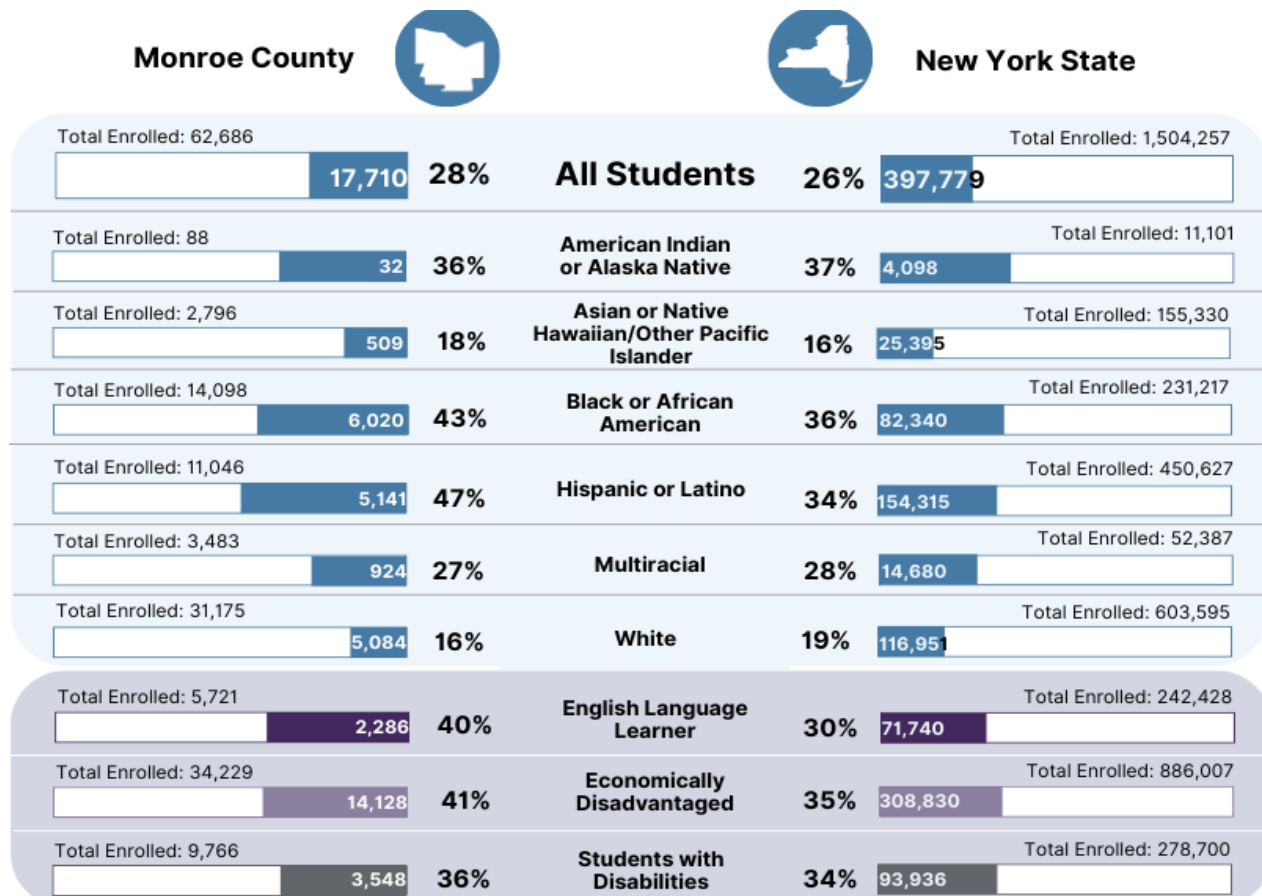

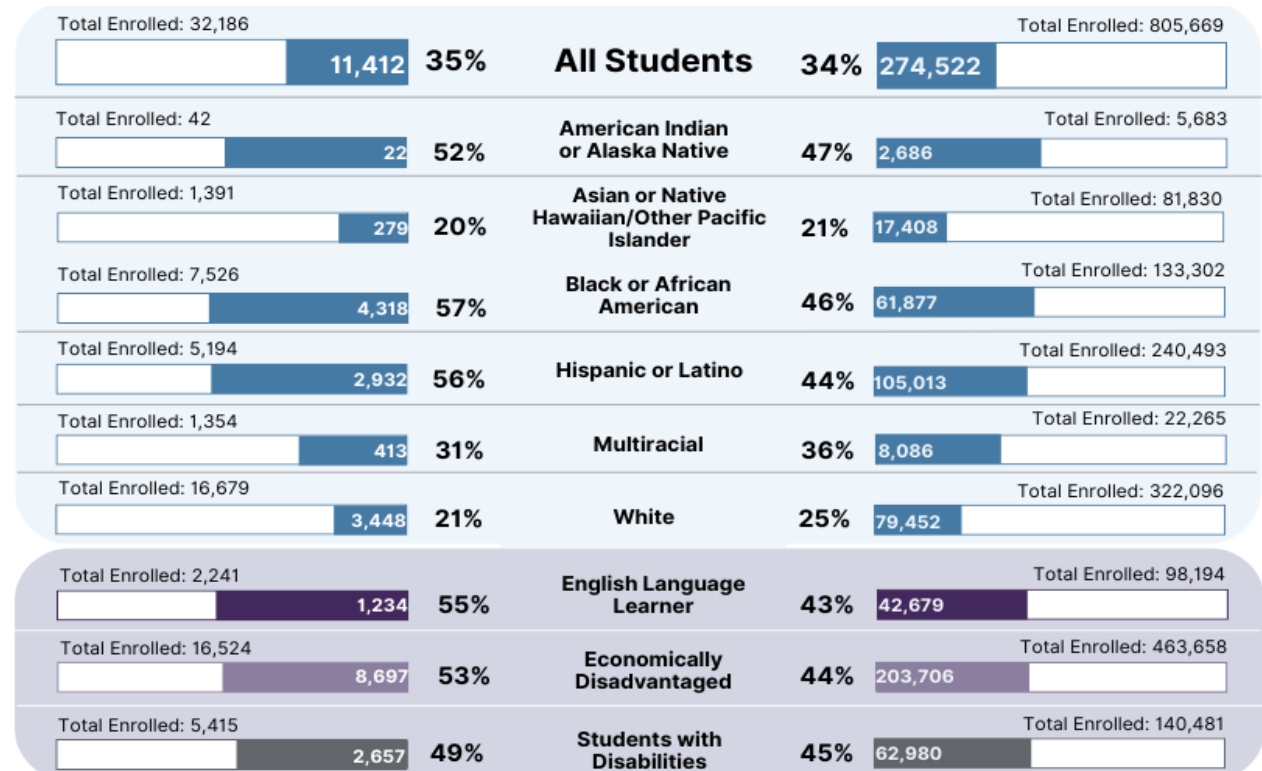

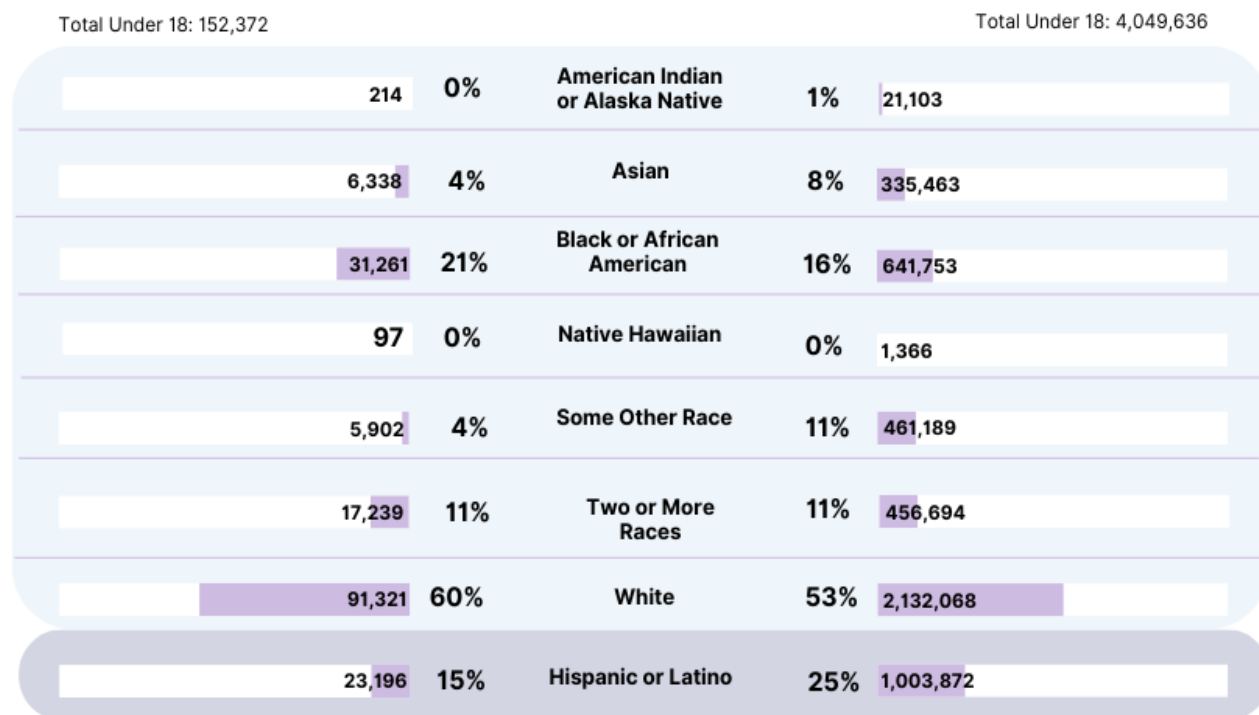
CHILD POPULATION DEMOGRAPHICS
